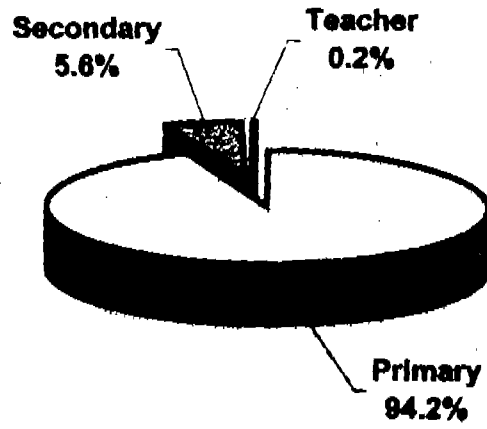

It is hoped that the booklet will prove to be even more useful to all people interested in the development of our education.

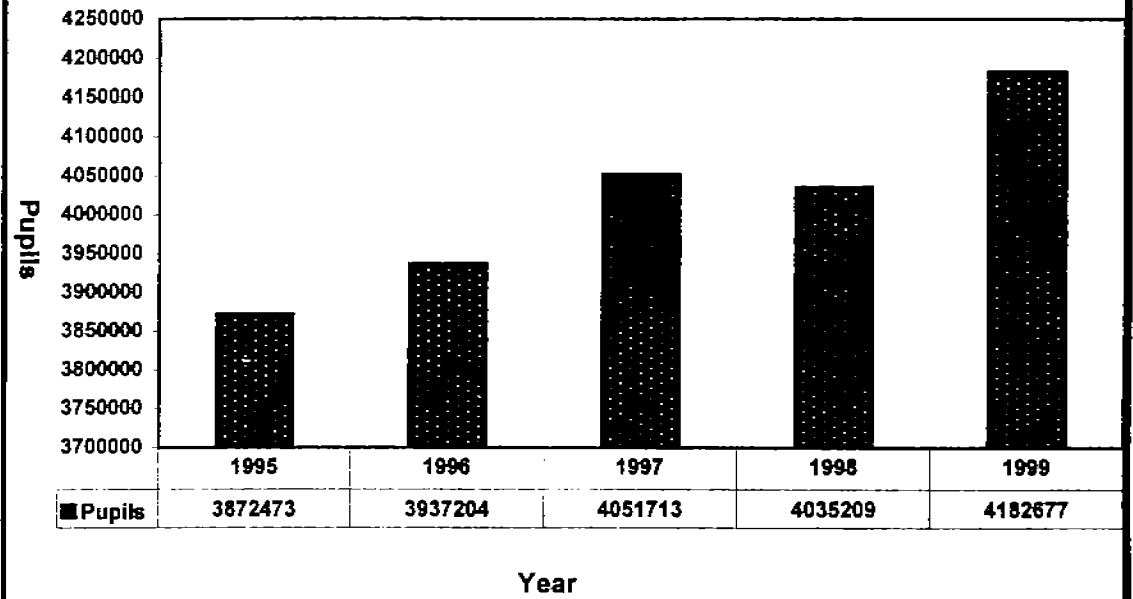
Once again, this Ministry welcomes suggestions and comments which we are certain, will go, a long way towards improving future issues.

Chart 1: Standard I - VII Enrolment in Public Schools 1995 - 1999

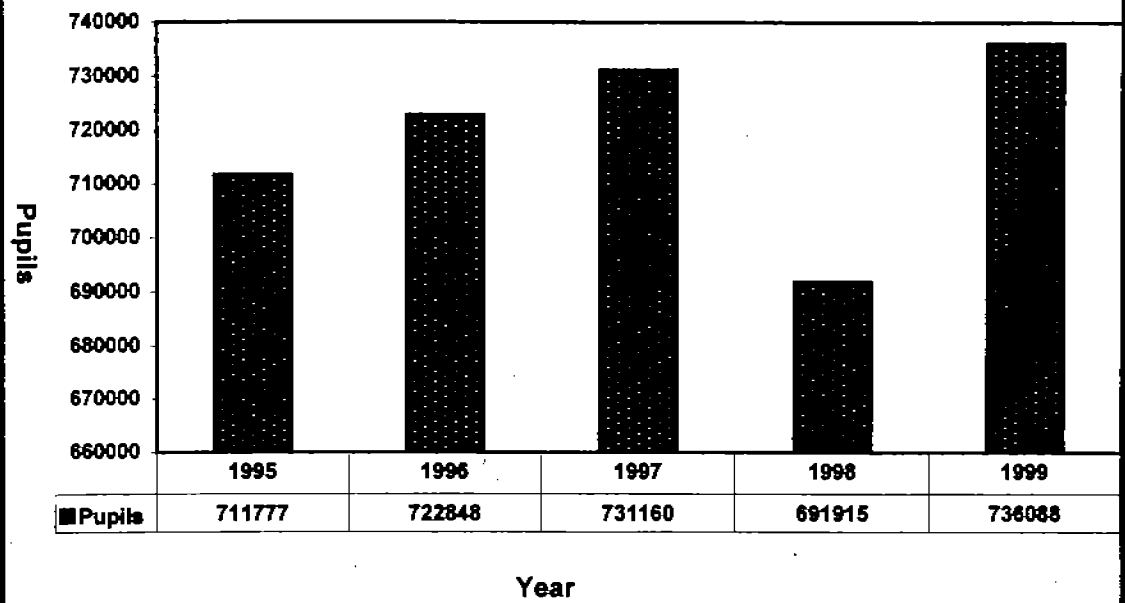

Chart 2: Standard 1 Enrolment in Public Schools 1995 - 1999

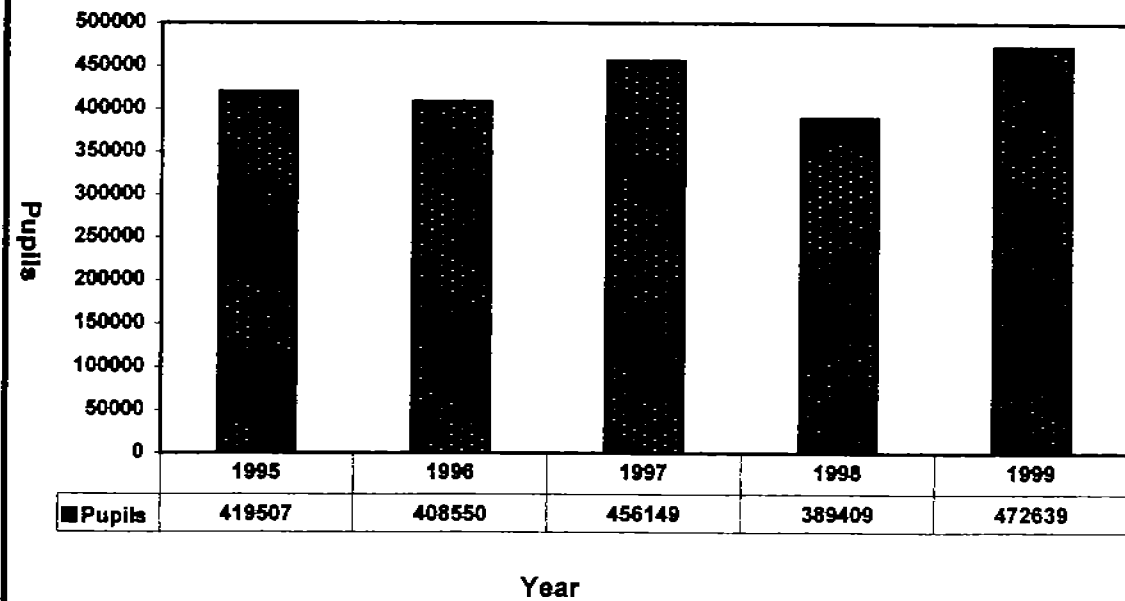

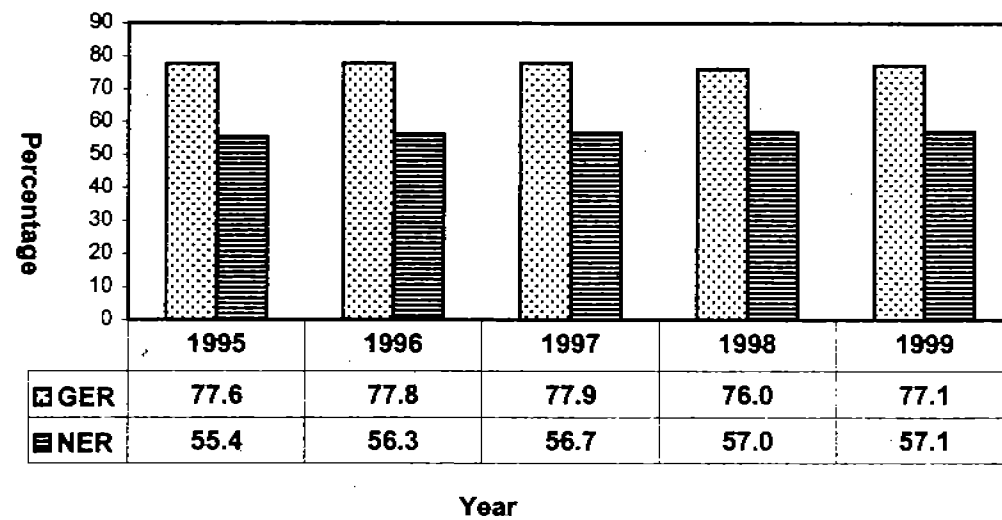

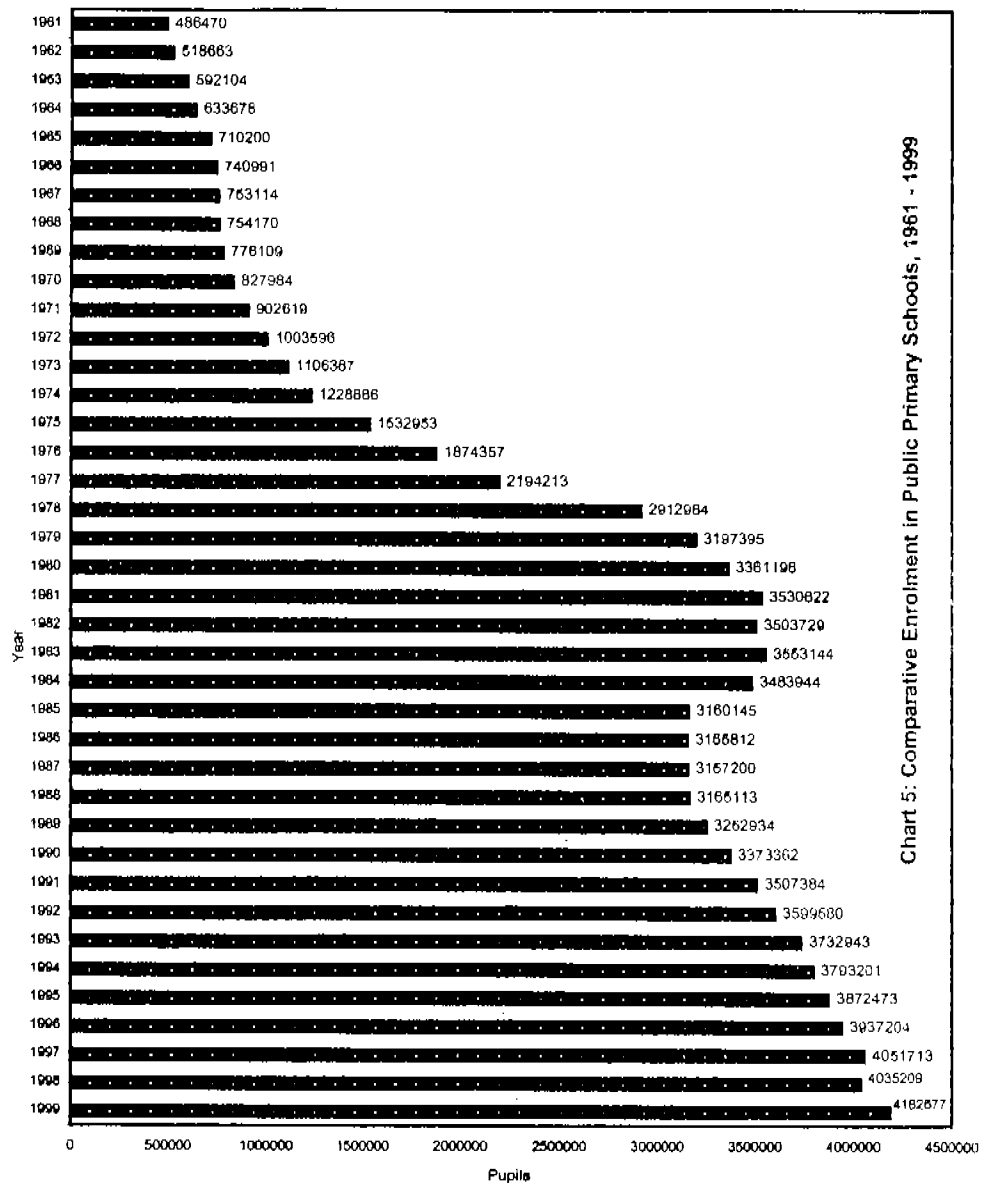

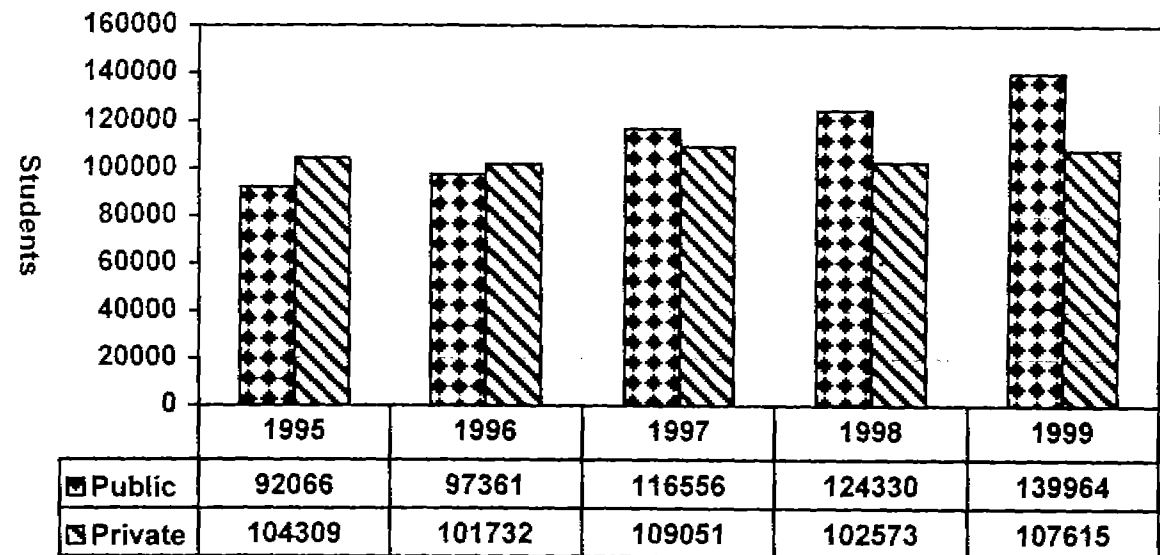

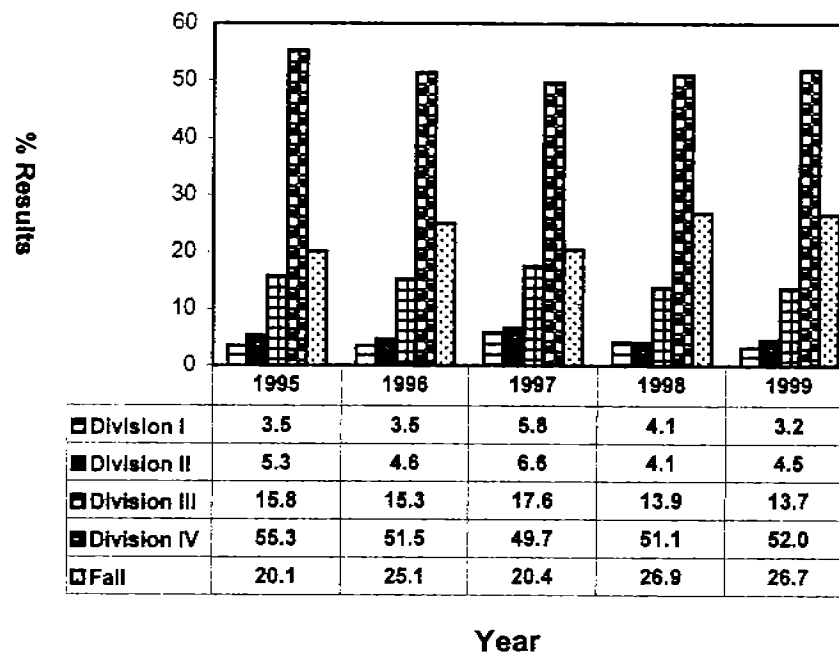

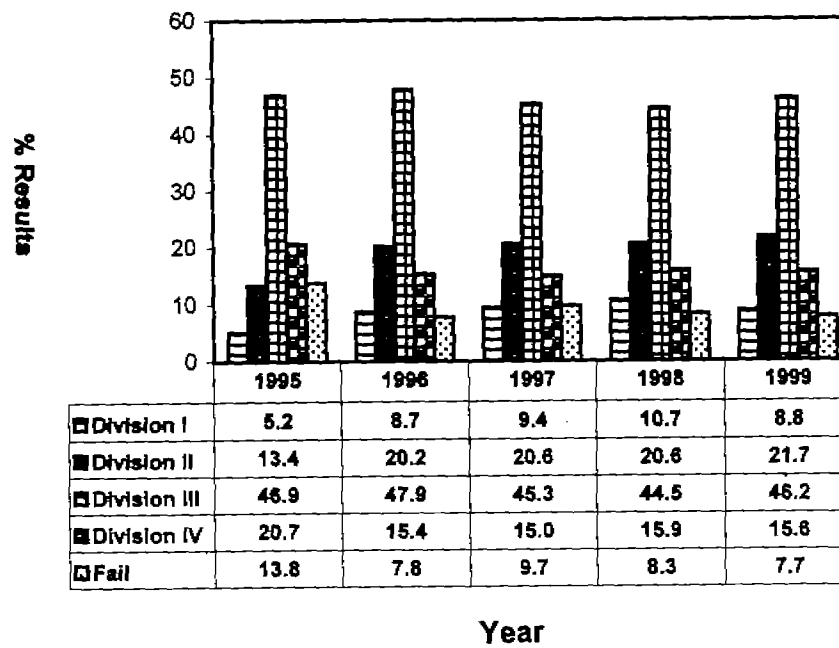

Chart 8: Form Six Examination Results in Public and Private Secondary Schools, 1995 - 1999



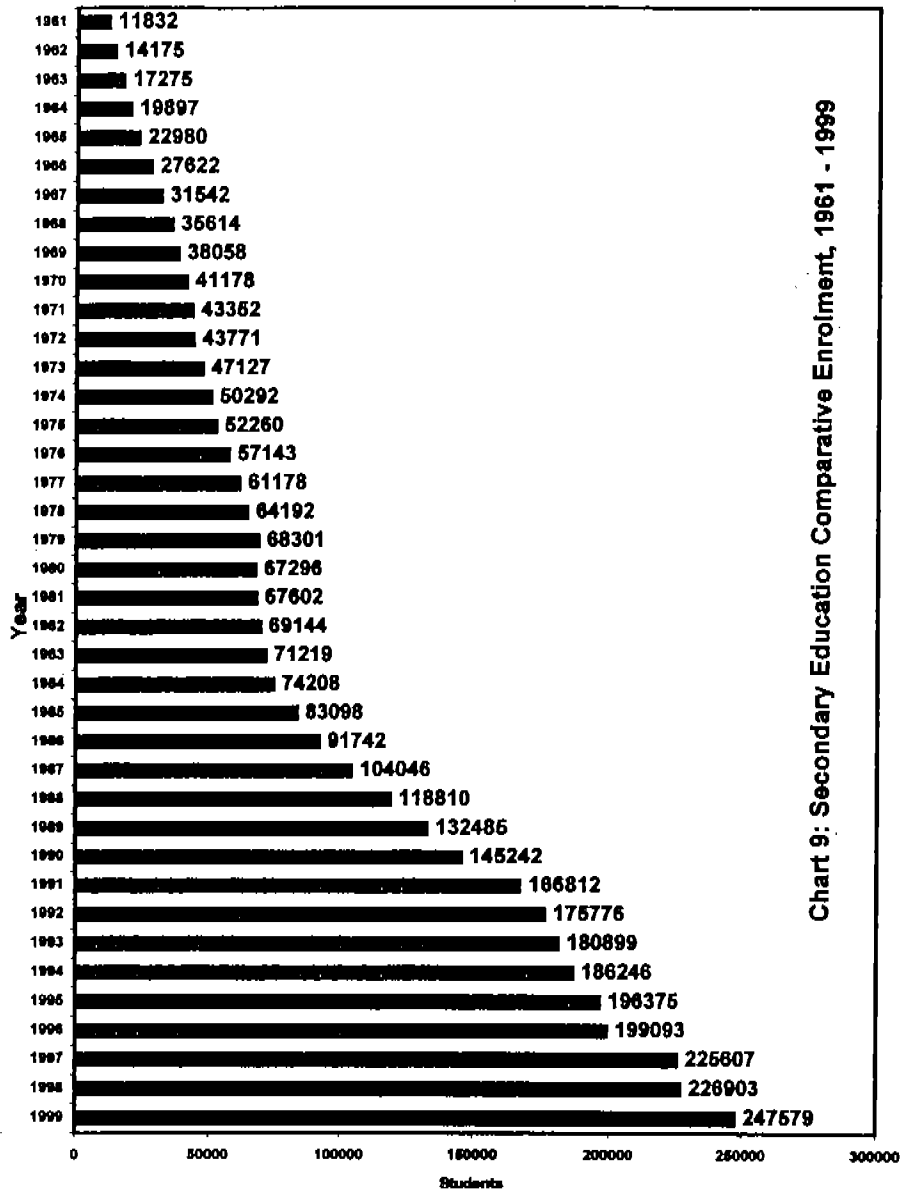

Chart 10: Teacher Education Enrolment by Level in Public Colleges 1995 - 1999

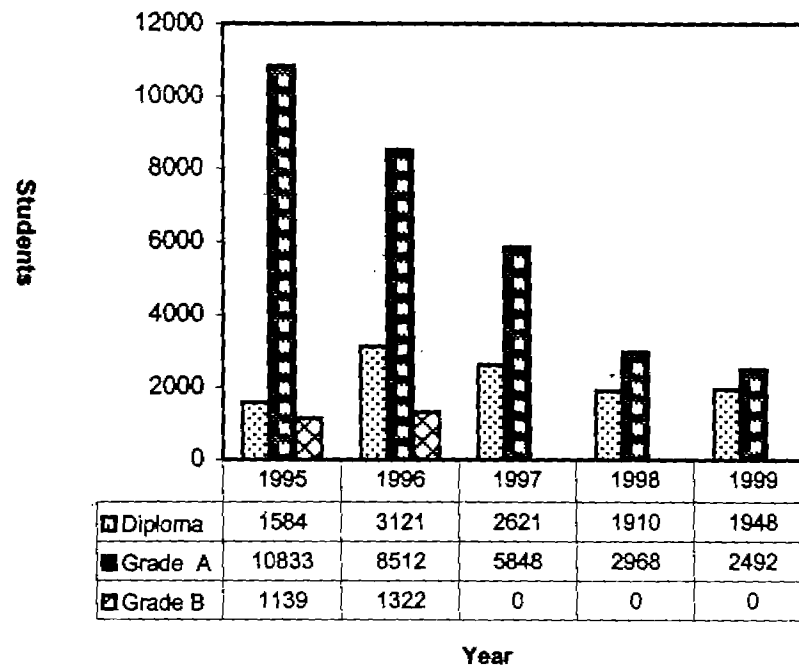


Chart 11: Teacher Education Enrolment in Public & Private Colleges, 1995 - 1999

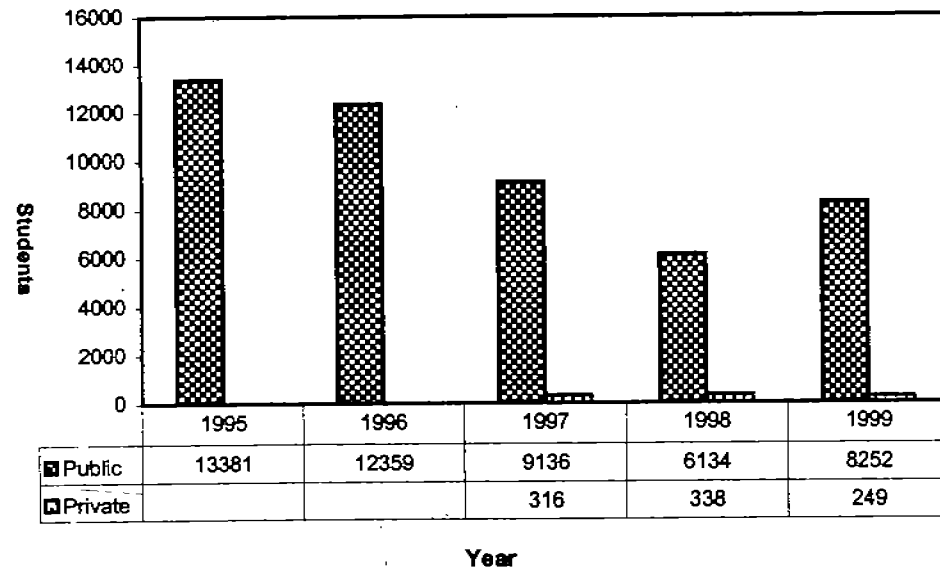

Chart 12: Education for Women, 1999

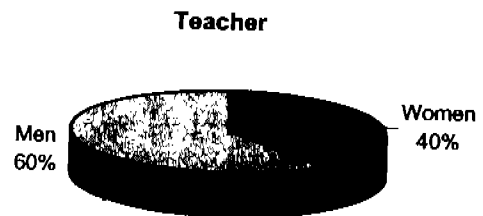
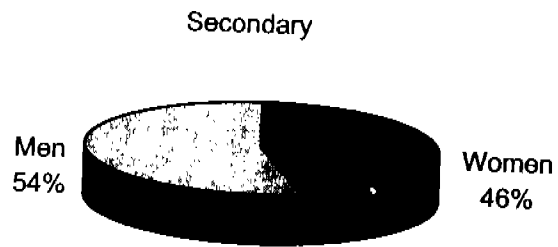
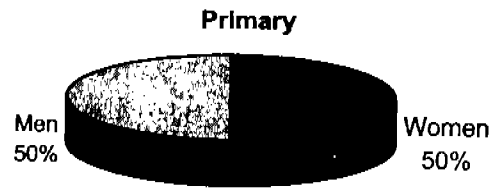
